Step 3: Application Process	<ol> <li>ID number is your departmental badge number</li> <li>Your payroll ID is NOT needed</li> <li>Select a Job Class that most closely reflects your responsibilities</li> <li>Agency Date of Hire</li> <li>Training: Bobcat and T3 training are available once you have access to the system         <ul> <li>Corrections: for APD personnel ONLY</li> <li>Tactical School: field personnel must have attended tactical school</li> </ul> </li> <li>Certification: Select if you wish to work in one of these positions         <ul> <li>Bike: exterior bike patrol</li> <li>Motor: motor escort</li> <li>SWAT: APD Tactical Response Team Member</li> <li>K9: APD Personnel only</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
Step 4: Administrator Verification	Your department will be contacted by an APD Administrator to verify you are clear to work off duty employment.
Step 5: Confirmation	Once your account is activated you will be sent an email from the Off- Duty System notifying you have access.
